- Participate in regular school planning meetings with Student Voice Coordinator
- Assist with the organisation and conduct of general assemblies and formal assemblies
- Speak on behalf of students and the school at school functions and other special events.
- Represent the school at events and functions as required.
- Report to the school community using appropriate communication pathways
- Mentor other students.
- Liaise with students in other leadership roles. This would include organising meetings with the purpose of improving student engagement and wellbeing in the school.
- Manage portfolio responsibilities which will contribute positively to the school community with relevant team members.
- Continuously improve leadership capacity by participating in leadership training.
