BYOD - BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE

User Agreement

Please read the conditions below. If you agree, sign the form and return to CAPA Staffroom.

1. The term "device" in these procedures refers to the devices outlined in the CCWTC BYOD Requirements sheet. Devices are used for education purposes primarily, failure to do so will result in the implementation of the school's discipline policy.

2. Students may bring their familiar devices to school and may access the school's Wi-Fi network. The Department of Education (DEC) will provide internet access through its wireless networks at no cost to students enrolled in NSW Public Schools at DEC sites. This internet activity is recorded and may be used in investigations, court proceedings or for other legal reasons.

3. Use of devices at school is governed by school-developed policy and procedures.

4. Students are responsible for the care and maintenance of their devices including data protection and battery charging and will use their own portal/intranet log-in details and never share them with others.

5. The DEC and Callaghan College Waratah Technology Campus will not accept any liability for the theft, damage or loss of any student's device. Students who bring their own devices onto school sites do so at their own risk.

6. Callaghan College Waratah Technology Campus will not provide hardware or technical support for devices other than connection to the school's wireless network. School owned hardware should only be connected to a device with the permission of the school.

7. Students and their parents/carers must complete this signed BYOD User Agreement prior to connecting to the department's Wi-Fi network.

8. Where the school has reasonable grounds to suspect that a device contains data which breaches the BYOD Agreement, they may temporarily confiscate the device for the purpose of confirming the existence of the material. Depending on the nature of the material involved, further action may be taken according to the school's discipline policy and if applicable referred to the police.

9. Use of BYOD devices in lessons is determined by the classroom teacher. Students are required to follow all teacher instructions regarding the use of BYOD devices.
