In this course, students will study the concepts of music (duration, pitch, dynamics and expressive techniques, tone, colour, texture and structure) through the learning experiences of performing, composing and listening. Students will perform solo or ensemble pieces on an instrument of their choice (including voice), write and arrange their own music or the music of other composers, as well as listen to and explore music from a variety of genres and cultures. Students will also have the opportunity to develop knowledge and skills in the use of industry standard recording equipment and techniques.

Students will study the Compulsory Topic, "Australian Music," and three elective topics chosen from an extensive list that includes such styles as: Popular Music (rock styles), Jazz, Music for Radio, Film, and Television, Music for the Theatre.

Students interested in performing at Variety Nights, performing as part of College Bands, or presenting items at the College Lizottes evening are encouraged to choose this subject.
