## ANTI – RACISM FLOWCHART



ACRO Coordinator receives complaint, conducts initial risk assessment and decides if complaint requires followup intervention. Classroom teacher creates incident in Sentral – provides detailed account and flags ACRO referral.

## **RISK ASSESSMENT**

- Risk of harm/child protection concerns?
- Possible criminal conduct?
- Does complaint need to be referred? eg. FaCS / Child Wellbeing Unit / EPAC / Police

INTERVENTION

Implement neccessary intervention strategies, advise Classroom Teacher and other staff as needed and communicate outcome of incident (if applicable).

## INTERVENTION STRATEGIES

- Mediation
- ACRO student behaviour reflection session
- ACRO intervention program
- Victim support



Evaluate outcome of intervention strategy and assess whether the matter is resolved or not. ACRO must keep a detailed If resolved, the complaint is closed. If not, continual referral along the Behaviour Continuum.
